Recognizing Members Who Reach 90 Years of Age

 Unit 390 members in good standing with the ACBL and reaching the age of ninety years, will be recognized with a card and a small gift delivered to their home (one-time only). Notification to a Unit 390 Board member must be made by the member reaching ninety or by someone representing that member. It is not the intention nor responsibility of the Unit Board to seek birthday information of any member.

Recognizing Members Who Reach 95 Years of Age

- Unit 390 members in good standing with the ACBL and reaching the age of ninety-five, will be recognized with Unit-reimbursed free plays for **face-to-face play** at all participating clubs. Notification to a Unit 390 Board member must be made by the member reaching ninety-five or by someone representing that member. It is not the intention nor responsibility of the Unit Board to seek birthday information of any member.
- 2. Unit 390 Board will notify participating clubs of any member identified in No. 1 above.
- 3. On a quarterly basis, participating clubs will submit proof (recap sheets) to the Unit 390 Board for reimbursement of any member identified in No. 1 above.
