"Ike is one of the nicest bridge players you will ever meet" — this is a statement you will always hear when his name is mentioned in bridge circles.


A Life-master, he is a veteran at the bridge table, a promoter of duplicate bridge in Calgary and a true gentleman.

Although 81 years of age and lately because of poor health, he has not been able to play regularly, he is as enthusiastic about the game as when he first started in 1923.

Ike is First World War veteran joining the forces when he was a teenager. Suffering from exposure, shell shock and fatigue he contacted tuberculoisis.

In fact, in 1922 he was given three years to live.

The same courage and



persistance he displays at the bridge table pulled him through his illness when the going was tough.

Recently an 81st birthday party was held in honor of lke at the Martinque Bridge Club, but at the last moment he was unable to attend. We are now planning for lke's 82nd Birthday Party.

Winners of the 1979 IKE LANDON NIGHT TROPHY


