A Life-master, he is a veteran at the bridge table, a promoter of duplicate bridge in Calgary and a true gentleman.


Many bridge players when they acquire their Life-Masters, only wish to play with those similarly qualified. Not Ike, he makes it a point to play with young or new players, encouraging them in the game and giving

them gentle and kindly advice. Although 81 years of age and lately because of poor health, he has not been able to play regularly, he is as enthusiastic about the game as when he first started in 1923.

Ike is First World War veteran joining the forces when he was a teenager. Suffering from exposure, shell shock and fatigue he contacted tuberculosis.

In fact, in 1922 he was given three years to live.

The same courage and



persistence he displays at the bridge table pulled him through his illness when the going was tough.

Recently an 81st birthday party was held in honor of Ike at the Martinque Bridge Club, but at the last moment he was unable to attend. We are now planning for Ike's 82nd Birthday Party.
