**Strati-flighted Swiss Teams A/X:**  
A: 3000+; X: 0-3000; (20 VP, plays alone)  
**Strati-flighted Swiss Teams B/C/D:**  
B: 1000-2000; C: 500-1000; D: 0-500; (20 VP)  
**Eligibility for flighted events:** Based on top player's MP total. Thereafter, strats determined by average of pair or team.  
**Conventions:** Midchart allowed in stand alone Flight A/X events and top bracket of KOs, except Compact. Mid chart defenses to opponents' 1NT openings are allowed in all events. *One bracket KO may be handicapped.*
